



CHAINSAW COURSE'S INFORMATION SHEET

1. The **CS30 (201 & 202)** deal with all the maintenance of the chainsaw and the techniques of crosscutting timber on the ground. This is run as one course and is run over 2 days.
2. The **CS31 (203)** is then the progression on the cutting of small trees up to 380mm (15 inches) in diameter. This course is three days chainsaw work and then assessment on the 4th day.
3. These two courses are usually done together over the period of one week. That is over 5 days. They can also be done separately with the CS30 done first and then the CS31 done next.
4. The **CS32 (301)** is a three day course and is the progression to working with larger trees (15 inches in diameter and above).
5. The **CS35 (302)** is a three to four day course working with windblown and fallen trees. This includes all trees from small to large.
6. The **CS38 (206 & 306)** provides training in tree climbing and aerial rescue techniques.
7. **CS39 (308)** provides training in tree climbing and use of a chainsaw from a rope & harness and removal of limbs and vertical trunk section, lowering operations and equipment.
8. CS38 & CS39 are usually run together as one course but can be done separately.
